### **General Arrangements for Face-to-face Class Resumption**

The EDB has recently announced that face-to-face classes will resume in two phases and also one-sixth of the total no. of students can return to campus for learning activities before the class resumption dates. As such, the school has made the following arrangements:

### I. Resumption Dates, School Hours, Timetable and Transport Arrangements

#### II. Extra Lessons & Other After-school Activities, Courses and Training, etc.

- 1. Extra lessons for the senior levels will be conducted via Zoom from 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. Students concerned will be informed of the schedule by their subject teachers accordingly.
- 2. There will be no detention class.
- 3. All after-school and Saturday activities, courses and training, etc. will be cancelled.

### III. Cancellation of Sports Day

Due to the uncertainty involving the spread of Covid-19, both the Sports Day (scheduled for 14/10 & 15/10) and the subsequent discretionary holiday (scheduled for 16/10) will be cancelled. They will become **Day 5 (14/10)**, **Day 6 (15/10) and Day 7 (16/10)**. Students will have to go to school for classes.

#### VI. Health Precautionary Measures

Cooperation from parents and students are important for us to maintain a clean and safe environment. We call on your support to step up environmental hygiene in the household, and, on top of that, implement the following measures strictly:

- 1. Pay attention to the health condition of your daughter. She should stay away from school and see a doctor immediately if symptoms of Covid-19, especially fever, are detected. If she is found to have the symptoms, especially fever while in school, you will be asked to come to school to take her to seek medical advice.
- 2. Take your daughter's temperature before she goes to school every day. Record it on the form for class teachers to check. (please see attachment)
- 3. Ask your daughter to wear a mask (also applicable when taking school buses, vans or other transportations) and bring tissue paper and hand sanitizer to school every day. The school is providing hand sanitizer in each classroom as well.

### VII. Stepping Up of Environmental Hygiene by the School

- 1. The school has been cleaning and disinfecting the school premises regularly. Also, the school has hired professional service to apply long-lasting antibacterial and antiviral coating to the school premises on 8/9.
- 2. All staff and visitors are required to wear face masks when they enter into the school premises.
- 3. Tuck shop and school bus operator have been cautioned of enforcing the rule of wearing
- 4. The use of water dispenser will be suspended. Therefore, students should bring their own water or they can buy from tuck shop. Tuck shop service resumes on 23/9, providing light snacks and drinks.
- 5. Students will be arranged to sit face-to-back in single rows and social distancing will be enforced in using the toilet and at the tuck shop.

With concerted efforts contributed by different parties, we look forward to overcoming the adversities of the pandemic to maintain a safe and healthy environment for all. If you have any further enquiries, please contact the class teachers.

## VI. 健康預防措施

- 3. 提醒 貴子弟每天佩戴口罩上學(包括乘坐校車、小巴或其他交通工具),以及携帶 紙巾和潔手液。學校已於每個課室放置潔手液。

### VII. 學校加強環境衛生

- 1. 學校恆常維持校舍衞生,定期進行徹底清潔和消毒;並已聘請專業承辦商將於九月 八日為校園進行持久抗菌和抗病毒塗料工程。
- 2. 教職員和訪客在學校範圍均佩戴口罩。
- 3. 已提醒小賣部職工和校車司機必須遵守佩戴口罩的規定。
- 4. 暫停使用飲水機。學生須自備飲用水,或到小賣部購買。小賣部九月二十三日恢復 營業,並提供小吃和飲品。
- 5. 學生上課,以面對背方式單行排坐;使用洗手間和光顧小賣部時,須遵從社交距離 的限制。
